Mayor's Office of Józsefváros Municipality of the Eighth District of Budapest

The office building of the Mayor's Office (Baross utca 63-67.) of the Municipality of the Eight District of Budapest is dog-friendly. All persons arriving with dogs are obliged to comply with the house rules of the building.

- 1. Small and large dogs, regardless of breed, size, or age, may enter the Mayor's Office, except for dangerous dogs, and may also enter all premises that allow them in and that display a special pictogram.
- 2. Dogs may be brought into the authorized areas of the Mayor's Office **on a leash or in a carrier**. Dogs may be handled only by a person who is competent to control, handle, and restrain the dog.
- 3. Only healthy, well-socialized, good-tempered, clean, and well-groomed animals may be brought into the building by the person who leads them/brings them in in such a way that they do not endanger the health and safety of others, disturb their peace, cause fear or cause material damage.
- 4. Only dogs that have been chipped and vaccinated against rabies may be brought into the authorized premises of the Mayor's Office.
- 5. The person who leads/brings the pet in must bring the **dog's vaccination book or the animal's passport**, which must be presented at the request of the staff of the reception service of the Mayor's Office in order to clearly prove the existence of a valid vaccination. The Office reserves the right to check the dog's vaccination book/passport and the presence of the identification chip at any time with the assistance of a specialist.
- 6. The person who leads/brings in the pet must pay particular attention to the order and cleanliness of the Mayor's Office.
- 7. If the animal defecates on the premises of the Mayor's Office, the person who leads/brings in the pet **must clean it up**, report the incident to the guard, and request disinfectant cleaning.
- 8. The person who leads/brings in the animal in a carrier and the owner of the animal are liable for all actions of the animal on the territory of the Mayor's Office in criminal, civil,

and misdemeanor law, so in case of damage for any compensation or indemnification, the person who leads/brings in the animal in a carrier and the owner are solely liable. Aggression causing injury or damage by a brought-in animal will result in a police report.

- 9. The Mayor's Office provides a **dog water dispenser** at the main entrance of the building.
- 10. The person who leads/brings the animal violates points 3, 4, 5, 6 of the House Rules, then the animal and the person who leads/brings the animal may be escorted out of the building.
